WYOMING SB/HP RIFLE SILHOUETTE CHAMPIONSHIP

The Lander Valley Sportsmen hosted the 2022 matches on July 23-24. Twenty-six shooters representing CO, ID, ND, SD & WY enjoyed the overcast and cooler than predicted temps while firing a 2 x 40 shot program with smallbore (SB) rifles. Sixteen also battled the high power (HP) 2 x 40 course with very good conditions until a Sunday PM wind shear BLEW IN, toppling all the target. Some fell backwards, others forward during the rapidly switching twister. A short time-out was taken, but too late to save the cabana sun shade. Shooters showed and tasted 'true grit' to continue on the sight-in swingers. Target resetting became a repainting of the swingers between relays.

Georgette Bradley, Berthold, ND was the only five trophy winner by winning all four Hi-Lady awards and HP class B 1st.

Standard SB Champion is **Scott Larson,** Pierre, SD @ 69; his 3rd in WY. First master is David Bonner, CO @ 62. Chris Farwell, CO earned 2nd M @ 58 with 3rd M going to Ryan Habeck SD @ 54. AAA class winners are Clint Habeck, SD 1st @62; 2nd Tom Kallemeyn, SD @ 58: 3rd Michael Her, CO @48 and 4th is Tony Cross, WY @ 47. Erik Smith, WY led the AA with 44 for 1st; 2nd to Larron Dolence, WY @ 43; 3rd is Tony Fuller, WY @ 39 and 4th is Sheldon Bradley, ND @ 37. Jonathan Sivertson, ND took class A @ 43.

Saturday noonish the HP rifles took the line and 80 shots later **David Bonner**, CO came out WY Champ with his 9th such @ 58. AAA 1st is Ryan Habeck's 53's. Chris Farwell's 52 is 2nd; 3rd @ 51 is Clint Habeck and 4th is [SD] Mark Sorensen's 48. AA class was a 1 point win for Sheldon Bradley @ 33 over high resident Larron Dolence. As noted earlier 1st B & hi-lady is Georgette Bradley @ 34.

A delicious dinner, lasagna, salad, garlic bread and apple pie was organized by Melissa Gray-Cross. Awards and door prizes completed the day's events.

Sunday the 24th, the hunting rifle division was conducted starting with the maximum 8 1/2# SB rifles. **Clint Habeck,** Fort Pierre, SD earned the Champion trophy & title @ 68. A shoot-off determined Chris Farwell's 67 as 1st M and Scott Larson 2nd M. David Bonner's 62 earned 3rd M. In AAA Tom Kallemeyn took 1st @ 45. Second @ 43 is Michael Ehr, CO. Another S/O gave 3rd to Tony Cross and 4th to Mark Sorensen after they tied @ 42. More tight scores put Roger Sebesta's 45 as 1st AA; 2nd Erik Smith @ 44; Georgette Bradley 3rd @ 43 and Larron Dolence 4th @ 40. Bruce Berg, WY topped the A's @ 31 and Jonathan Sivertson's 33 won B and should move him into class A.

The final 2 x 40 on the program had HP hunting rifles on the line. **David Bonner,** directed his 260 Rem to capture his 10th WY Championship @ 51. Master 1st is Clint Habeck @ 46. In AAA Scott Larson led the way @ 46. A S/O for 2nd-3rd was won by Chris Farwell giving 3rd to Mark Sorensen after their tie @ 41. Tom Kallemeyn's 41 took 1st AA with 2nd @ 30 Sheldon Bradley. Hi-Resident and 1st A is Larron Dolence @ 30. The final S/O broke the tie @ 25 with Jonathan Sivertson winning B class over Georgette Bradley.

Since 2009 the Lander Sportsmen have awarded a 4-Gun aggregate trophy. This year it goes to **David Bonner** with 235 / 320; his 12th WY 4-Gun award.

The same five Lander students reset targets both days, quickly, and courteously. They really appreciated the tip jar results!
